
CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

SOCIAL TENNIS


Interested in having a social hit with other members? There are supervised Social Groups held weekly. Come along and have a hit. No need to book—just come along. For further information contact the relevant person below.

Over 1 year as a minimum you should restring by the number of times you play in a week e.g. 4x per week = 4 restrings per year **Why restring?**

Injury prevention and maximise your equipment. Does my string suit my game? Loss of tension in restring- string loses 10% of tension even straight after being restrung!

Loss of control:

String loses tension over time= loss of control of the ball- Loss of spin "snapback effect"- your game will lose spin and effect of your shot.

Visual evidence a restring is needed:

Fraying or deep "notches" where the main and cross strings join

Speak to Steve today for individualised advice on string. Why not get what is best for you and your game? Steve is a Tennis Australia High Performance coach and has been doing restrings for over 20 years.
